Dear Valued Distributor Partner,

We are writing to proactively notify you of **potential transportation delays** related to a significant winter storm system expected to impact the **Northeastern United States from February 23–28, 2026**. Forecast models show **heavy snow, strong winds, and reduced visibility**, with blizzard conditions likely across major metropolitan areas including New York City, New Jersey, and southern New England. The National Weather Service indicates **1–2 feet of snow** may fall in many areas from Feb 23–24, with additional disturbances bringing periods of light snow, mixed precipitation, and gusty winds through Feb 28. Several states are preparing for possible travel restrictions due to hazardous conditions. [\[cbsnews.com\]](#)

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### Impact to Shipments

Due to the severity and duration of this weather pattern, shipments moving into, out of, or through the Northeast may be affected by:

- **Heavy snowfall and blizzard-level visibility reductions** Feb 23–24. [\[cbsnews.com\]](#)
- **Additional snow showers, freezing temperatures, and strong winds** extending through Feb 28. [\[bing.com\]](#)
- **Potential road closures, travel bans, and slowed highway conditions** across the region. [\[cbsnews.com\]](#)

Despite active coordination with our carrier network, unavoidable weather-related delays may occur.

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### What You Can Expect

- Carriers may issue **revised pickup and delivery windows**, particularly during the Feb 23–24 blizzard period.
- Depending on location and storm severity, shipments may experience **1–2+ days of transit extension**.
