You may be aware that on January 5, 2026, Nestlé announced a recall of some infant formula and Alfamino products in some countries.

I want to let you know that this recall does not affect Nestlé products sold in the United States. Alfamino and all other Nestlé products in the United States are safe to consume and meet all FDA safety and quality standards.

Following the detection of a quality issue with an ingredient provided by a leading supplier, Nestlé has undertaken testing of all arachidonic acid (ARA) oil and corresponding oil mixes used in the production of its potentially affected infant nutrition products. The recall is strictly a precautionary measure.

Food safety and the wellbeing of all infants remain our top priority. We understand that this news may cause concern, and we are committed to providing clear, transparent information and support for parents, caregivers, and our partners.
